Anna was a lifelong resident of the Ashland community, a graduate of Patrick Henry High School '07 and a rising senor at Lynchburg College. She was the starting goalkeeper for the women's soccer team and earned All State honors in 2009. Anna's life was cut short in a tragic car accident in 2010.

Anna's love for life and others brought many people together to raise funds for a well at Koro Farm in Gulu, Uganda that is dedicated in her memory. This well dramatically changed the lives of the people it serves. Koro Farm has been able to grow and serve more people over the last 11 years because of Anna's Well.

The Women of Worth Project is a mentorship project of the Lynchburg College Women's Soccer Team.
