Anna was a lifelong resident of the Ashland community, a graduate of Patrick Henry High School '07 and a rising senior at Lynchburg College. She was the starting goalkeeper for the women's soccer team and earned All State honors in 2009. Anna's life was cut short in a tragic car accident in 2010.

Anna's love for life and others brought many people together to raise funds for a well at Koro Farm in Gulu, Uganda that is dedicated in her memory. This well dramatically changed the lives of the people it serves. Koro Farm has been able to grow and serve more people over the last 11 years because of Anna's Well.

The Women of Worth Project partnered with Fostering Hope to provide day care and assistance to local foster care families and parents. The University of Lynchburg Women's Soccer Team created the Lynchburg Sports locker to assist low-income families in the area with equipment needs. The team also created the Lynchburg Youth Sports Initiative that provides community play days, free pop-up sports clinics and assistance for youth sports.
